RE: Saniblend 256

This is in reply to your letter of October 29, 2019, wherein you requested our comments on the acceptability of the subject product for use as a disinfectant and cleaner in food processing establishments. The product is intended to be used on floors, walls, storage areas and equipment in food processing establishments.

Based on the information provided, we can advise that we see no reason to object to its use as proposed for use in food processing establishments, provided that:

- a) There will be no contamination of food as a result of its use and storage;
- b) Prior to the application of the product in food handling areas, all food should be removed from the vicinity or protected; and
- c) Equipment and surfaces subject to direct contact with food are thoroughly rinsed with potable water after treatment with the product.

Please note that any product with disinfectant claims requires a Drug Identification Number (DIN) registration that is under consideration of the Natural and Non-Prescription Health Products Directorate (NNHPD) of Health Canada.
